It was decided that a new member was not necessary at this current time. The committee will continue to evaluate and will revisit at a later date. Sue's experience with Technology at another school was noted and could be considered for the qualities we want from the person that would fill the open seat in the future.

Teacher iPad replacement was discussed. Mark will obtain a quote to bring back in March. Laurie will talk to each teacher group to evaluate the teachers' current needs in regards to the iPad.

There have been some recent subscription changes with the Palo Alto web filter that we currently use. Jason will get more details to bring to the March meeting.

Ink purchases were discussed and the need to reduce that cost. Mark will be meeting with Jon Cross to discuss possible options. Mark will have a recommendation for the committee at the March meeting.

A scheduled network outage has been approved for Friday, February 17, 2017 – (3:00-5:00 PM), confirmation from the parish office will requested.
