IP Provider Update:

Student iPad Refresh Plan:

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade Ipad will be collected at the end of the year, refreshed and turned in for partial reimbursement of approximately \$60 per device.

Summer Work:

- Mark is working with Keller Schroeder on projects that are needed to be completed over the summer. One item on the list is to evaluate where the current APs are located and try to place them where best can function and purchase the needed new APs in the primary hall.
- The team will also be working on security for the 1:1 devices that will provide the same security at home that it does at school.

ISTEP:

- State readiness test will take place on February 7.
- We have received a waiver for ISTEP Parts 1 & 2 in Grades 3-5 to test paper/ pencil. Grades 6-8 will test online for both Parts 1 & 2.

Computer Lab:

- Mark is working on making sure all headphones are working and purchasing any needed new headphones.
- Mark will also be working with Keller Schroeder on junior high login credentials on all desktops in the lab. This will be completed over the summer.

Kaspersky Administration Update:

- We are in need of a Kaspersky upgrade. Mark is working with Keller Schroeder on getting that in place.

1:1 iPad Program Funding

- Mark will have a potential plan to present at the February meeting.
