## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Easter Decorations We will meet on Friday, April 15 to arrange the potted flowers in the large planters so that they will be ready to be placed in church on Saturday morning. Judy will order the flowers and ferns again this year. We plan to hang the Risen Jesus quilt above the Baptismal Font.
