The "Pledge of Allegiance", was written by Frank Bellamy in 1892 to help kids celebrate the 400th anniversary of the founding of America. On April 22nd 1951, the Knights of Columbus adopted a resolution to amend the pledge to include the phrase "Under God", when recited at each of it's meetings. This soon caught on, and all councils, then most gatherings followed suit. Then, U.S. Rep Louis Rabaut, a Catholic, introduced a bill, and this was passed and on June 14th 1954, President Dwight Eisenhower signed on it. So, that's kinda cool how we did that, ain't it ??

A Louisville businessman, Matt Winn stepped in to help. Matt formed a syndicate of investors and saved the Derby. Matt also served as the first Grand Knight of the first Knights Council that established south of the Ohio River. 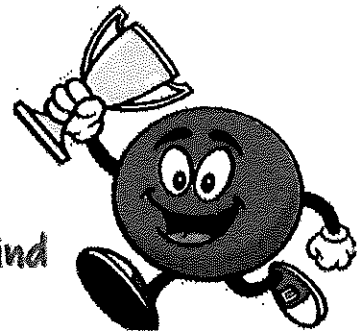
Attention all ladies of Good Shepherd!! Please join us for a night of food, fun, and fellowship at our annual Kickball Tournament.
