murdered priests and slaughtered

Mass-goers by the thousands. The

our brothers in Mexico, and got

involved and sent 1 million down

there to help U.S. Ambassador fix

the problem. The Christeros were

a legendary group of people who

stood up for their Church. Many of

these were martyred for their faith.

25 priests were martyred and many

More are canonized including 14 yr

old St. Jose Luis Sanchez del Rio. The

Christeros would encourage each

other by saying, " Viva Cristo Rey"
