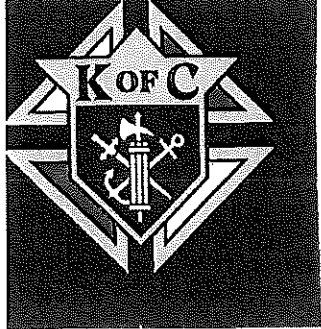
Cost of materials, including a book and workbook is \$26 plus s/h.
