Cardinal fans should be at meeting since Pirates will have beaten them in afternoon game . Pujols 0-4, 3 K's

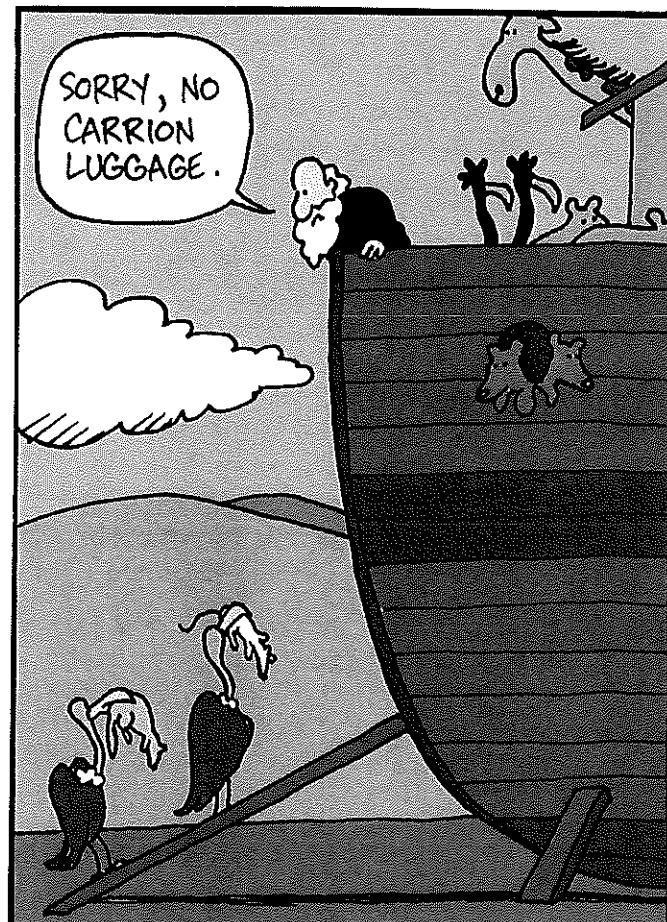
Daily Prayer for Priests

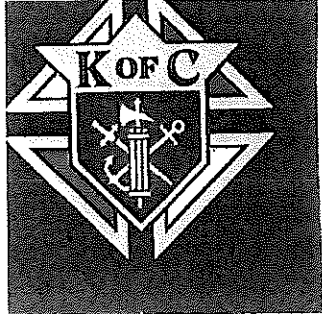
~St. Therese of the Child Jesus

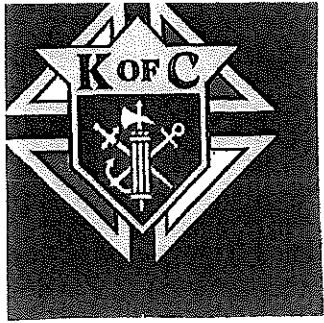

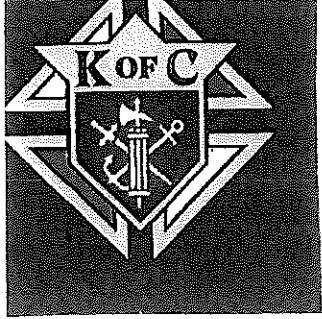
