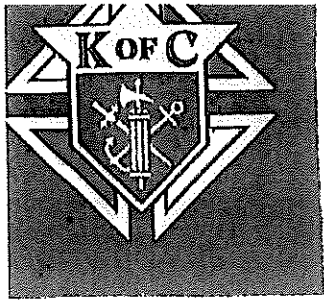


Fancy Knights shirts are in !!!

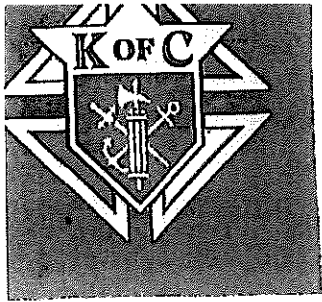

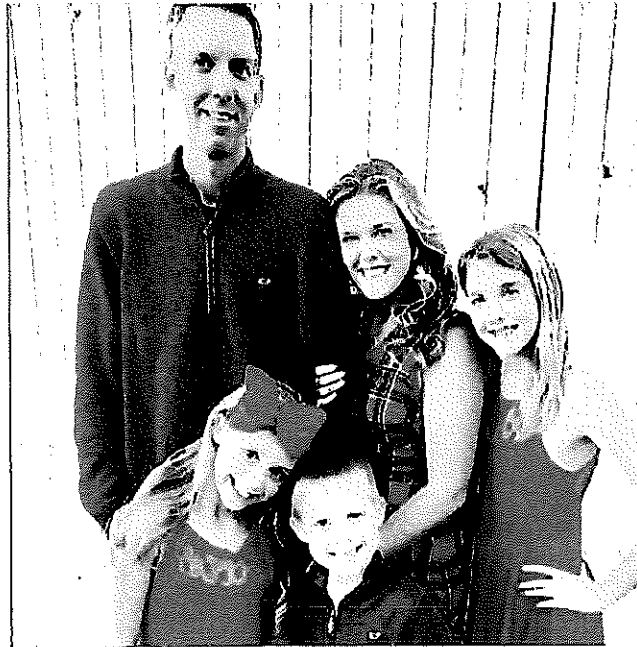

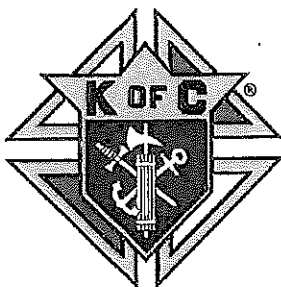
