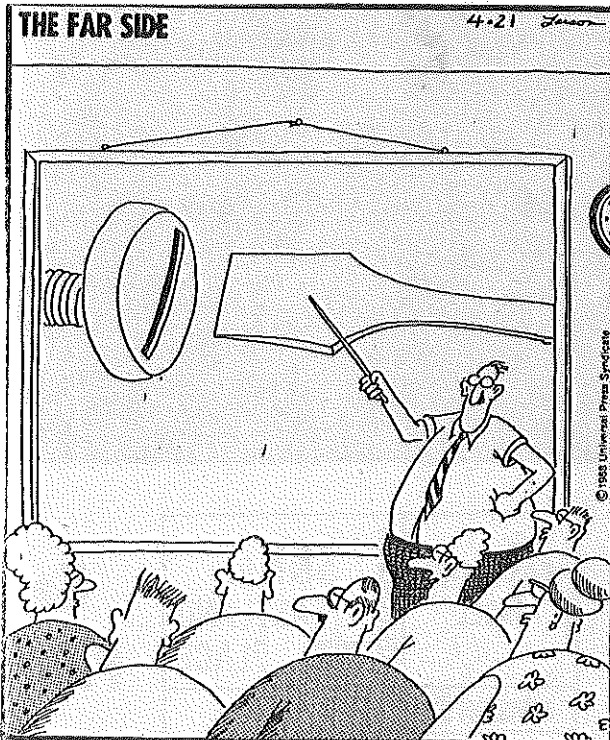

Financial Secretary know by our August 4th meeting so that he can cover us. Just give him a number of folks you might need tickets for. We had a lot of folks attend last year!

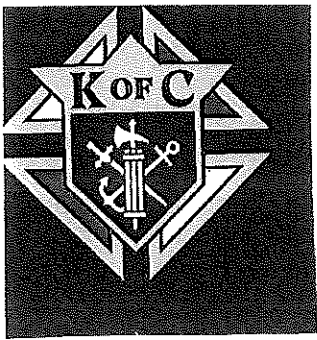


School for the mechanically declined

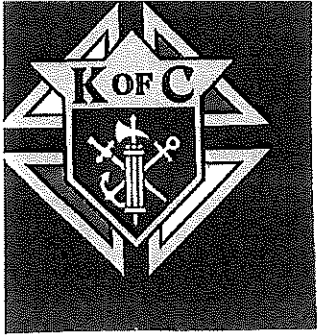
Next Meeting : Aug 4th - You can't miss this one !!!

ARISE Adoration

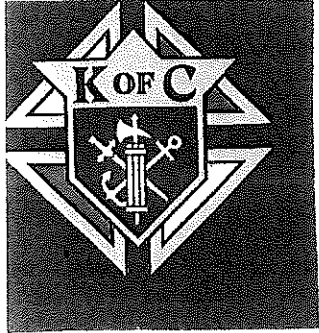

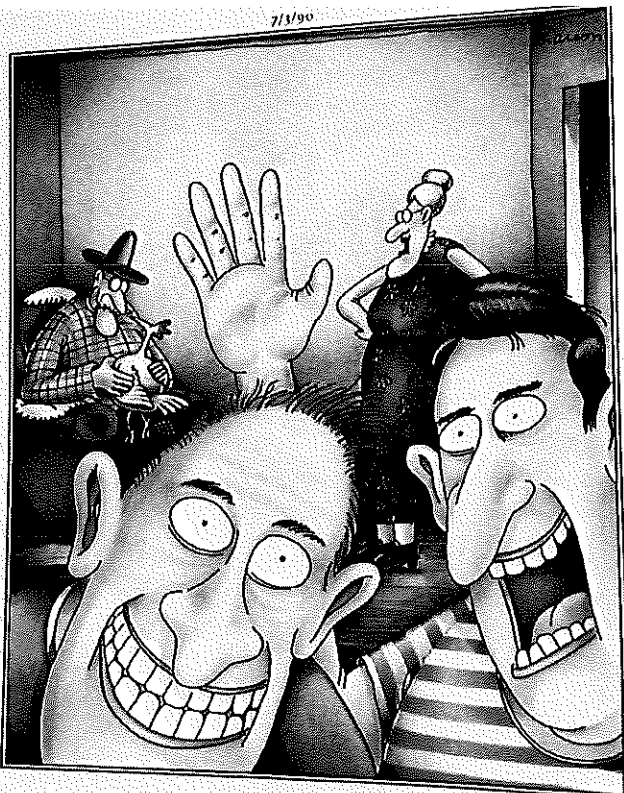

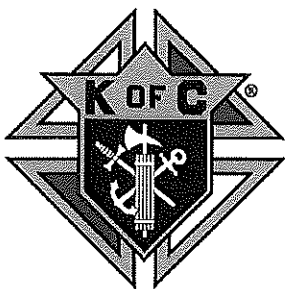
