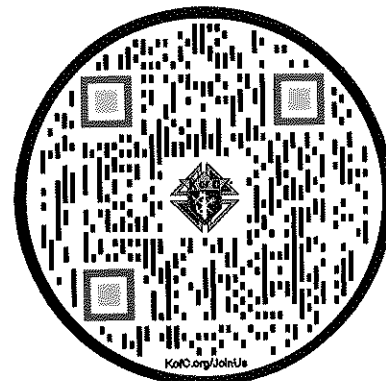
## Lenten Study Workshop

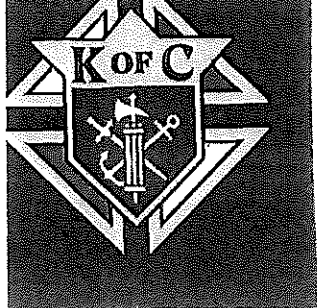

The class abruptly stopped practicing. Here was an opportunity to not only employ their skills, but also to save the entire town.

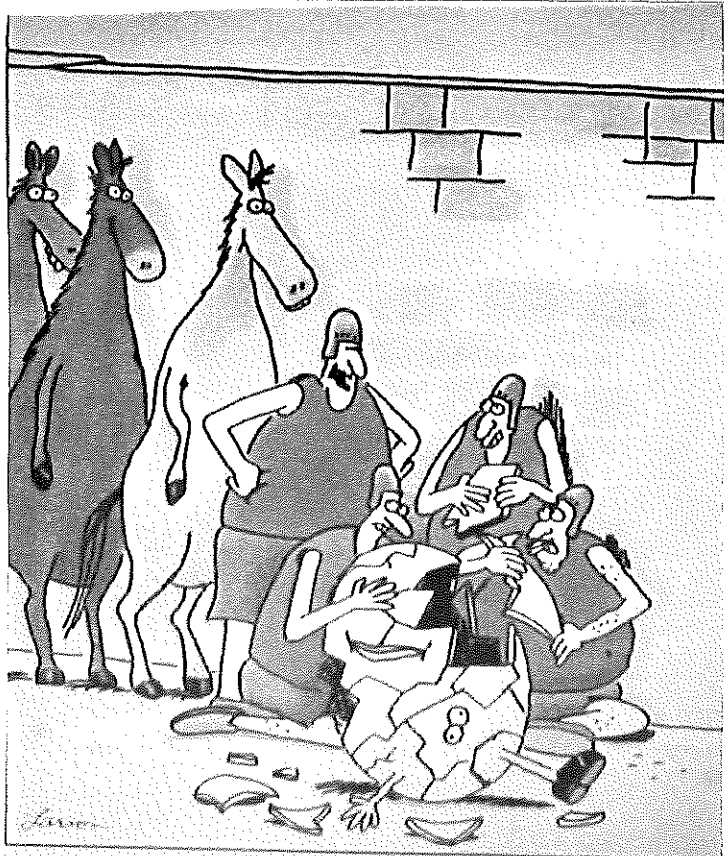

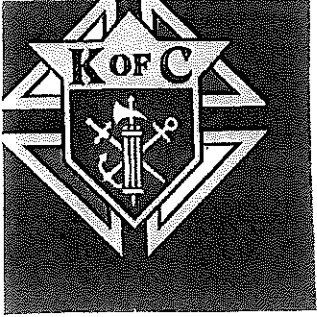
## Good Shepherd Ultreya

**So, let's get ready to rumble !!!**



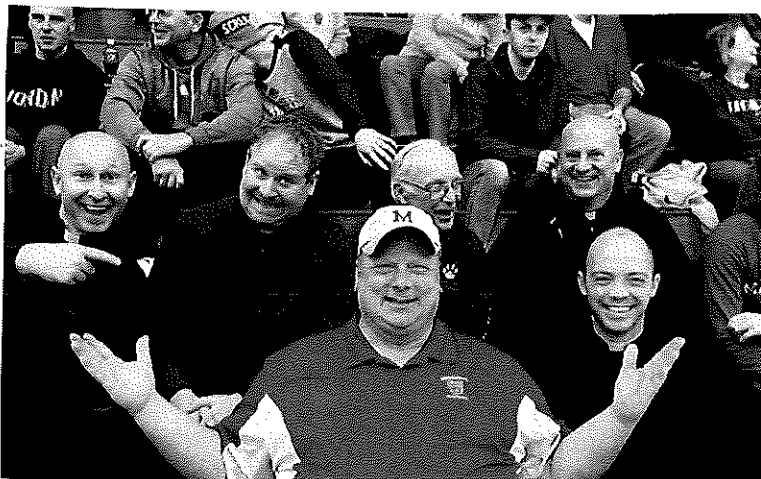

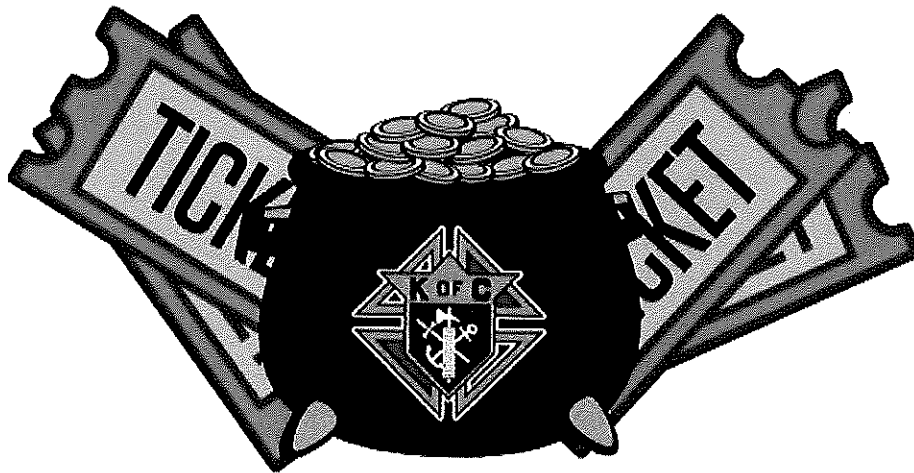
